This artwork is the outcome of a comic workshop, run by **Tomek Giovanis**, illustrator and comic artist, which took place in the premises of the Network for Children's Rights in Athens, during the Refugee Week Greece 2023. The workshop was attended by children and young people of the Network as well as unaccompanied minors who live in shelters and SIL apartments of Society for the Care of Minors (SMAN) and International Rescue Committee (IRC) Greece. The story of the comic is the result of the participatory writing of a fairy tale by unaccompanied refugee children hosted in HOUSE2, the shelter of SMAN, and the transit accommodation facilities of METAdrasi.

The shelters for unaccompanied minors of IRC, METAdrasi and SMAN are being funded by **EEA Grants** under the "Asylum and Migration" (Addressing urgent needs for the reception and screening of asylum seekers and for the accommodation of vulnerable groups) programme in Greece. The programme, with a total budget of 16,5 million euros as part of the **EEA Grants 2014 – 2021**, aspires to contribute to ensuring legal protection, support and care for the most vulnerable asylum seekers, with emphasis on unaccompanied children. The Fund Operator for the "Asylum and Migration" programme is **SOL Crowe** in partnership with **HumanRights360**.
